

# Cookie Policy

Cookies are small strings stored locally in the user's browser to exchange information with the website.

These strings are used for various functions, including session analysis, storing information to improve browsing experience or website functionality. Cookies saved during browsing may come from the website itself (first-party) or be installed by tools or objects contained within the website (third-party).

The general provision of the Privacy Authority (GU No. 126 of June 3, 2014) and subsequent guidelines define two types of cookies:

- **Technical cookies** – Used solely for the purpose of enabling communication, completing a requested service, or conducting statistical research.
- **Profiling cookies** – Used to record user behavior and preferences to send advertising messages in line with their profile.

## Types of Cookies

These are the cookies used by Oriente Occidente Impresa Sociale - Ets within the website.

Category	Type	Purpose
<b>Technical</b>	First-party	These cookies enable the proper functioning of the website and user navigation preferences, such as language selection or access to restricted areas. Users can delete or disable them, but this may compromise some site functionalities. Refer to the "Disabling Cookies" section of this policy.
<b>Functional</b>	First-party	Functional cookies help perform certain functions, such as sharing website content on social media, collecting feedback, and other third-party functionalities. Disabling these cookies may compromise some site functionalities.
<b>Analytical</b>	First-party	Analytical cookies are used to understand how visitors interact with the website. These cookies provide information on metrics such as visitor numbers, bounce rates, traffic sources, and more. Disabling these cookies may compromise some site functionalities.
<b>Performance</b>	First-party	Performance cookies are used to understand and analyze key website performance indicators, helping provide a better user experience. Disabling these cookies may compromise some site functionalities.
<b>Advertising</b>	First-party	Advertising cookies are used to deliver personalized ads based on previously visited pages and to analyze the effectiveness of advertising campaigns. Disabling these cookies may compromise some site functionalities.
<b>Other types of cookies</b>	Third-party	Third-party cookies are set by domains other than the visited website. They are used to integrate external features such as

embedded content, analytics services, targeted advertising, and social media interactions. They track user navigation across different sites (e.g., YouTube) and personalize the experience based on user preferences.

## Disabling Cookies

Google Analytics cookies can be disabled through the browser add-on or by clicking on the following link.

### Disable Google Analytics cookies

Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default. However, users can control and disable cookies through their browser settings. Restricting cookies may affect some website functionalities.

Alternatively, users can disable cookies from specific providers via the tool available at <http://www.youonlinechoices.com/>.

Below are the procedures for disabling cookies in common browsers:

### Google Chrome

1. Open Chrome on your computer.
2. Click on **More**, then **Settings** at the top right.
3. Scroll down and click on **Advanced**.
4. Under **Privacy and Security**, click on **Site Settings**.
5. Click **Cookies** and then:
  - o To enable cookies: turn on "Blocked."
  - o To disable cookies: turn off "Allow sites to save and read cookie data."

### Mozilla Firefox

1. Click on the **Menu** button and select **Preferences**.
2. Select **Privacy & Security**, then navigate to the **History** section.
3. Under **History Settings**, select **Use custom settings for history**.
4. Check or uncheck **Accept cookies from websites** to enable or disable cookies.
