

Privacy Policy

Oriente Occidente Impresa Sociale - Ets recognizes the importance of protecting personal data and is committed to respecting user privacy, handling private data with care and confidentiality, and not using it for purposes other than those specified below.

This policy describes how the website manages personal data of users who visit it, in accordance with Article 13 of the EU Regulation No. 2016/679 (GDPR).

This Privacy Policy applies only to this website and not to any other websites visited by users via links.

1. Data Controller

2. Personal Data Processing

Oriente Occidente Impresa Sociale - Ets informs users that collected data will be used exclusively for the following purposes.

2.1. Browsing Data

The website's IT systems collect certain personal data automatically during normal operation (e.g., IP addresses, domain names of user computers, URI addresses of requested resources, request times, response status codes, etc.).

Although these data are not collected to identify users, they could potentially be associated with other data sources to do so.

Purpose and Legal Basis:

These data are used to ensure the website's proper functioning and security. The legal basis is the legitimate interest of the Data Controller (Art. 6.1(f) GDPR).

3. Data Processing Methods

Personal data will be processed mainly through electronic tools with appropriate security measures.

Data will be retained only for the time strictly necessary to fulfill processing purposes and will then be deleted or anonymized.

4. Data Recipients

Personal data may be disclosed to:

- Employees and collaborators of the organization, authorized to process data;
- IT support and maintenance providers acting as Data Processors under Article 28 of the GDPR;
- Marketing and communication agencies managing the website;
- Public authorities when legally required.

Data will not be disseminated to third parties.

5. User Rights

Under Articles 15-22 of the GDPR, users have the right to:

- Access their personal data;
- Request rectification of inaccurate or incomplete data;
- Request deletion of their data (right to be forgotten);
- Restrict data processing under specific conditions;
- Request data portability;
- Object to data processing for legitimate reasons.

6. How to Exercise Rights

Users can send their requests via email to **info@orienteoccidente.it**.

7. Withdrawal of Consent

Users can withdraw their consent at any time by writing to **info@orienteoccidente.it**. The withdrawal does not affect the legality of prior processing.

8. Right to Lodge a Complaint

If users believe their data protection rights have been violated, they can file a complaint with the **Data Protection Authority** under Article 77 of the GDPR.
